MDwise is an Indiana-based health coverage company. We provide Indiana families access to high quality health care. MDwise works with the state of Indiana to provide medical, dental, vision and behavioral health benefits through the Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP) and Hoosier Healthwise programs.

How does the MDwise plan work?



MDwise is your health plan. You will choose one doctor who will work with you to keep you and your family healthy. By visiting MDwise.org or calling customer service at 1-800-356-1204

MDwise Hoosier Healthwise and Healthy Indiana Plan have earned Health Plan Accreditation. This means MDwise passed reviews on quality standards and performance measures.

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Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP)

What is the Healthy Indiana Plan?

The Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP) is an affordable health insurance plan that serves Hoosier adults between the ages of 19–64 who are not eligible for other Indiana Health Coverage Programs or Medicare. This plan also includes pregnant women.

You could qualify for HIP if you meet all of the following requirements:

- You are an adult between the ages of 19 and 64 without a disability.
- You are not eligible for other Indiana Health Coverage Programs or Medicare.
- You have a household income equal to or less than 0-138 percent of the FPL (Federal Poverty Level).
- You are a legal U.S. resident.

You could also qualify if you meet all of the above requirements and:

- You are a parent or caretaker relative eligible under Transitional Medical Assistance.
- You qualify for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF).

There are two HIP plans. Each plan has different benefits.

HIP Plus Benefits

- Includes dental, vision, and chiropractic services
- Low monthly contributions
- No costs for medical services

HIP State Plus/Basic

- Same benefits as HIP Plus
- Medically frail
- Transportation services are covered
- Costs for medical services (State Basic)

HIP Basic Benefits

- Minimum essential coverage
- Costs for medical services
- May be more expensive

HIP Maternity

- No copays or POWER Account Contributions
- Transportation services are covered
- Dental, vision, and chiropractic services are covered

What is a POWER Account?



All MDwise HIP members have a Personal Wellness and Responsibility Account or "POWER Account." Members use the account to pay for their first \$2,500 of covered medical

services. Preventive services are free and unlimited. They are not taken out of your POWER Account.

Your POWER Account is made up of your monthly contribution and the state's contribution. Your monthly contribution is calculated by your family size and income. Once you pay your first monthly contribution you are enrolled. An employer or other third party organization can assist with some or all of your monthly POWER Account contribution. Go to mdwise.org/employerthirdparty for details about employer or third party contribution.

MDwise Healthy Indiana Plan members can get many health services including:

- Doctor check-ups.
- Behavioral and mental health care.
- Dental and eye care (depending on your health plan).
- Maternity services for mothers during pregnancy.
- Free rides to doctor visits depending on your health plan.
- Prescription drug coverage.
- Surgeries, inpatient, outpatient and emergency services.
- Web-based health and disease information.

What's not covered?

There are some health services that are not covered by the HIP program. For a complete list of these services see the Healthy Indiana Plan member handbook. The member handbook is available on the MDwise website at MDwise.org/handbookHIP.



Hoosier Healthwise

What is Hoosier Healthwise?

Hoosier Healthwise members get a variety of health care benefits and services. You can see a doctor for preventive care visits. We can also help you get transportation to your doctor and dentist. Or we can get you information about community services close to you.

You could qualify for Hoosier Healthwise if:

- You are under the age of 19 living in a low-income household.
- You qualify for food stamps.
- You are a pregnant woman not already enrolled in or eligible for the Healthy Indiana Plan.

MDwise Hoosier Healthwise members can get many health services including:

- Doctor check-ups.
- Behavioral and mental health care.
- Free rides to doctor visits except Package C members.
- · School-based health services.
- Dental and eye care.

- Prescription drug coverage.
- Surgeries, inpatient, outpatient and emergency services.
- Web-based health and disease information.

What's not covered?



myMDwise is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week at MDwise.org. When you use myMDwise, you can:

- View your general eligibility information, including the name of your current doctor.
- Print or access your member ID card.
- Answer questions about your health (Health Needs Screening).
- View and redeem MDwiseRFWARDS.
- View your POWER Account balance (HIP members only).
- View your pharmacy claims.
- See if your claim qualifies as a preventive service

(HIP members only).

Member programs

MDwise offers special programs and enhanced services to help you and your family stay healthy. MDwise wants every member to feel valued and respected. MDwise programs are developed so members get help when they need it. In each member program, it is important everyone feels welcome. Please call your Customer Service team if you need assistance or language support. Below are the programs we offer to our members.

Connecting programs:

- WELCOMEwise Calls to new members to introduce them to their benefits and complete HNS. Members can call customer service at 1-800-356-1204 to complete their HNS
- Lets Connect Calls to new members to introduce them to care management and care coordination. Members can call 1-800-356-1204 to connect with care management.
- OPPORTUNITYlink Connects members to care via kiosks at various community partner locations. You can visit mdwise.org to find an OPPORTUNITYlink kiosk in your area.
- Better Together program A comprehensive healthcare initiative
 that prioritizes personalized hands-on care to improve the well-being
 of MDwise members, relying on Community Health Workers who
 serve as vital links between members and their care management

Disease Management programs:

- INControl B/P cuffs, scales Providing education, BP cuffs, Scales, and asthma kits for chronic diseases. Members can work with their care manager to learn more education as well as obtain needed kit.
- SMOKE/VAPEFree Assists members with smoking/tobacco cessation. Members can call I-800-QUIT-NOW and contact their primary doctor for assistance to stop using tobacco.
- CityBlock Improving outcomes for low-income and marginalized communities. Members eligibility will be identified through Care management and directly contacted to participate in the program.

Member Education Programs:

• **HEALTHwise** – Platform for evidence-based member education. Visit mdwise.org and click on Wellness Tools to learn more information on a variety of health topics. Members can also connect with care management for more information.

Rewards Program:

Social Needs programs:

- FOODwise Program to provide food assistance to members at risk for food insecurities. Members can access this program through notifying customer services of the need as well as through interaction with care management. Call customer service at I-800-356-1204.
- GA Foods Home delivered meals through GA Foods for members with complex needs, CHF, CAD, DM, COVID, NICU. Members who are identified through Care Management with complex needs can access the program with their care manager for meals to be delivered to their home. Contact customer service at I-800-356-1204 to connect with your care manager.
- HELPlink MDwise members who need assistance with social needs such as food, education, housing, jobs and more can find local resources by visiting gethelp.mdwise.org, or by contacting customer service at 1-800-356-1204 for assistance.
 - o **WORKwise** WORKwise is your one-stop career center to receive employment and training services. MDwise launched WORKwise as a partnership with Midwest Urban Strategies.**The program offers:**

- · Job and Interview Training
- Resume Writing
- Skills Tests
- Education

WORKwise can also support those entering the workforce with transportation, childcare and access to uniforms and tools.

- **LEADwise** Members at risk or dealing with high lead levels and connects them to resources. Members who are identified through care management as at risk for elevated lead levels or identified as having high lead levels will be contacted by care management.
- LEARNwise Provide resources to members wishing to complete their high school equivalency. Members can contact customer service at I-800-356-1204 advising they need financial assistance to complete the HSE exam.
- READwise Promote literacy by providing books to children.
 Members can connect with this program through their school.
- RECOVERYwise Safe housing for individuals with SUD/OUD.
 Members can work with care management to get connected with recovery housing options in their area.
- RIDEwise Provides HIP/HHW members with transportation to medical appointments. Members who are eligible for transportation through their benefit plan can call customer service at I-800-356-1204 to schedule their ride.
- Transportation Connection Provide members transportation above and beyond the benefit to places such as the pharmacy, to secure food and attend support groups. Members may access this program through contacting customer service at I-800-356-1204 to express the need.
- SAVEwise Provide members with various discounts for needed services. Members can access the SAVEwise program by logging into your myMDwise portal and click on the SAVEwise link.
- VAXwise Program Program is to assist MDwise and the

community with immunizations. Members can check out our events calendar on <u>MDwise.org/mdwise/events</u> to see when the next Back on Track event will be in your area to take advantage of the program.

Pregnancy programs:

- BLUEBELLE's Beginnings is a program for MDwise members who are pregnant. MDwise holds Bluebelle's community baby showers for pregnant members across the state. We also provide pregnancy information and resources.

- Indiana Pregnancy Promise Program Free voluntary program for pregnant members who use opioids or have used opioids in the past connecting individuals to prenatal and postpartum care, other physical and mental health care, and treatment for opioid use disorder. MDwise REWARDS

MDwise has a rewards program for Hoosier Healthwise and Healthy Indiana Plan members. You can earn points to get FREE gift cards. You can go to MDwise.org/MDwiseREWARDS for more information. The following activities are some of the ways you can earn points:

- Sign up for myMDwise and give us your email address.
- Answer questions about your health (Health Needs Screening).
- Get your yearly physical exam or check-up.
- Get all required well-child exams.
- Get your annual mammogram.
- Go to all of your prenatal appointments.

- Go to your postpartum exam.
- Complete HbAlc annual screening if you have diabetes (special blood sugar test).
- Get a Lead test for all one and two year olds.
- Get a flu shot.
- Complete a tobacco cessation program.
- Get a follow-up appointment within 7 days of a mental health inpatient hospital stay.

You don't have to sign up for MDwiseREWARDS to earn points. Members are automatically enrolled. You can go to MDwise.org/MDwiseREWARDS for more information. If you don't have Internet access, you can call MDwise customer service.
